CHAPLIN CIRCUS SHOW:

For the Easter holiday, a Big Top will be set up in the park at Chaplin's World, with circus performances for audiences of all ages!

Corsier-sur-Vevey, Switzerland (22 March 2022) - From 15 April to 1 May, experience the wonderful atmosphere of a 1920s circus at Chaplin's World! As a tribute to Charlie Chaplin's love of the circus, a Big Top will be set up in the park. Fresh new talents and experienced circus performers will present a special show combining unique acrobatics and drama. Also on the program: film screenings under the Big Top, and outdoor games so that visitors of all ages can try their hand at the circus arts.

For a two-week period, before, on, and after Easter, families will be treated to shows performed by the Alchimie circus school under a Big Top set up in the grounds of the Chaplin's World estate in Corsier-sur-Vevey, where Charlie Chaplin spent the last 25 years of his life. Three times a day, children, teens, and professional artists will give a 40-minute special performance inspired by Chaplin's iconic film The Kid. Circus performances at the museum had been suspended since 2019, so we're delighted to see them back!

These shows are produced and supported by the Charlie Chaplin Museum Foundation.

LONG LIVE THE CIRCUS!

Charlie Chaplin loved the circus, saying of his iconic character, 'the Tramp,' that there was something clownish about him, with his baggy pants, oversized floppy shoes, and clumsy ways. In all in years in Switzerland, he never missed a show put on by the Knie family, from the Swiss National Circus, who were close friends of his.

<u>L'Alchimie circus school's</u> upcoming performances at Chaplin's World draw on Chaplin's classic films, with a particular emphasis on The Kid, which is being celebrated at the museum this year. Come and see a joyful jumble of high-speed chases, hat jugglers, monocycle riders, trapeze artists, and acrobats, to the live sound of a youth orchestra playing Chaplin's musical scores!

KID-FRIENDLY ATTRACTIONS

In a 1920s circus atmosphere, visitors of all ages can try their hand at circus arts in the museum grounds, with plate spinning, a coconut shy, juggling, and hula-hoop stands. A selection of tempting fairground treats under the Big Top will also whet their appetite!

CHAPLIN CIRCUS SHOW!

15 April-1 May 2022, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. at Chaplin's World.

Family fun in the park at Chaplin's World: circus performances, walkabout performers, sweet treats, and circus games open to all in a fairground atmosphere!

Big Top circus performances - Three daily 40-minute shows at 11 a.m., 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. (There will be no performances on Thursday 19 and 26 April).

On days off, two screenings of "The Kid" will be held under the Big Top, at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.

On 16 April, celebrate Charlie Chaplin's birthday and the sixth anniversary of Chaplin's World!

With a special screening of "The Kid" in the Studio at Chaplin's World at 6:30 p.m., introduced by Chaplin's son, Eugene (Admission: CHF10. Reservations required book your tickets at chaplinsworld.com)

Weather permitting, a tethered hot air balloon will fly in front of the Manor, providing a magnificent view of the lake and the Alps.

The circus performances and screenings under the Big Top are included in the price of admission (except the special screening on 16 April, with an introduction by Eugene Chaplin).

The hot air balloon rides are not covered in the price of admission.
