CHAPLIN'S WORLD BY GRÉVIN CELEBRATES ITS FIRST ANNIVERSARY

The Museum has already welcomed close to 300,000 visitors.

***Corsier-sur-Vevey, March 21, 2017** – A year has passed since the official opening of Chaplin's World By Grévin, on April 16, 2016. The museum, dedicated to the life and work of Charlie Chaplin, has found its audience, and become a sponsor for key players in the area. It's time to reflect on this year of achievements, exchanges, and celebrity sightings.*

In its first year, Chaplin's World By Grévin has hosted visitors from all over the world. People of all ages and 75 nationalities have rubbed shoulders to visit Charlie Chaplin's last home – the Manoir de Ban at Corsier-sur-Vevey, by Lake Geneva – and the large Hollywood-style studio located in the grounds of the estate. The positive reactions of the general public, and those of the national and international press, are extremely encouraging for the future.

GLOBAL OUTREACH FOR THE REGION

Reporters from more than thirty countries have already visited the museum, and media response to its opening has shone a clear spotlight on the region: "The phenomenal enthusiasm of the press for Chaplin's World really helped promote the destination on an international scale, contributing to a 7% increase in overnight stays on the Montreux Riviera in 2016," Christoph Sturny, Head of Montreux-Vevey Tourism, explains.

A few months after it opened, Chaplin's World By Grévin was honoured to receive the Swiss Tourism Award of Excellence in Bern, and the British Guild of Travel Writers Award in London. It was also nominated for a Swiss MICE Award in Zurich in the 'Events: Unusual Sites' category.

WHAT'S NEW FOR VISITORS

Chaplin's World By Grévin welcomes visitor feedback in order to improve their experience and the site's amenities. In addition to providing information in three languages (English, French, and German), the museum is developing a new application that will make the visit easier to understand for an even greater variety of visitors (available in Italian, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese, Russian, Arabic, and Japanese).

To sustain visitors' interest, Chaplin's World is also planning a series of cultural events and activities for people of all ages. In this regard, Charlie Chaplin's vibrant heritage offers bright prospects.

**FIRST ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS AND
WORLD RECORD TRIBUTE TO THE TRAMP**

To mark the first anniversary of Chaplin's World By Grévin, and Charlie Chaplin's birthday, the museum is planning to set the record for the world's largest gathering of people dressed as The Tramp, on April 16, 2017. The event will be carried out under the supervision of Mr. Marco Breitenmoser, an adjudicator in Geneva.

To reward people dressing up on this Easter Sunday, a big Easter-egg hunt with hundreds of prizes (including hotel nights, meals, hot-air-balloon flights, museums tickets, and many more) will be held in the park, Chaplin-family-style.

Entrance fee includes Tramp kit (moustache, cane, and bowler hat), participation in the egg hunt (restricted to those wearing the required costume, per rules and regulations), and entrance to the museum.

The day of festivities will feature activities for all visitors, whether or not they are in fancy dress.

Nestled between a lake and the surrounding mountain range, five minutes from Vevey, in Switzerland, Chaplin's World By Grévin is a fun museum dedicated to Charlie Chaplin, the man and the artist. Designed by Philippe Meylan and Yves Durand, with support from Genii Capital, and stage designed by the Confino Agency and By Grévin, it provides entertainment and culture for the general public. It's also a cult place for film-lovers and Chaplin fans. The great man's sense of humour and emotion, which won the hearts of audiences worldwide, is displayed over 3,000 sq m of themed trails, at the Manoir de Ban – Chaplin's home for almost twenty-five years – and its Hollywood-style studio. Chaplin's World is the fourth international site developed by Grévin.
