COVID-19: CHAPLIN'S WORLD BY GRÉVIN WILL REOPEN ON 13 JUNE 2020

Corsier-sur-Vevey, 8 May 2020 - For its reopening, on Saturday 13 June 2020 at 10 a.m., the museum will implement the preventive sanitary measures required by law. The pop-up exhibition "The Sound of Charlie Chaplin," which was designed and produced by Musée de la Musique-Philharmonie de Paris, and had to close the day after it opened to the public, has been extended until 30 September.
